Phoenix Advocates at Disability Day at the Capitol

We did it! Your passion and enthusiasm were top notch, the stories were emotional, and we left our mark during Disability Services Day at the Capitol! **THANK YOU to all the family members and staff who joined us for this historic advocacy day!**

Nearly 1,000 advocates filled the Capitol Rotunda for the first time in three years. We rallied, chanted, and demanded investment in disability services. We met with 17 of our 19 Minnesota Legislators to talk about the challenges we face every day.

It was an eye-opening experience that reminded us how necessary it is to prioritize inclusivity and support marginalized groups—and to do it together with our fellow disability providers. Thank you to everyone who came or reached out to their legislators this session!

On the COVID front, we are settling into this "new normal." By now, everyone is used to working in a COVID environment, and we're continuing to do all we can to prevent COVID from entering into our homes. When it does, we are well prepared to tackle it head-on while keeping everyone safe.

You can rest assured that our nursing team is continually monitoring all the recommendations and requirements from the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) & the Centers for Disease Control (CDC). Because we are a medical facility, we are still required to follow all COVID protocols for long-term care facilities.

Staff in our 6-bed ICF homes are still required to wear masks and eye protection when providing care for your loved ones. We are still asking family members and all visitors to complete a symptom screening when visiting, as well as staff when they arrive for their shift. You can rest assured that we'll keep you updated on any COVID developments as we receive them.
